## Overview

Joe's practice covers the full spectrum of commercial disputes, including litigation, arbitration and advisory work. He has particular experience with complex group litigation and has been instructed on various high profile cases in that area, including the Fundão Dam proceedings, one of The Lawyer's Top 20 Cases of 2025, and the s90 and s90A FSMA claims brought against Glencore (Aabar & Ors v Glencore Plc).

Joe is regularly instructed as part of very large counsel and solicitor teams, but is also comfortable working as sole counsel, and has appeared unled in the Commercial Court.

Joe's current and recent instructions include:

Acting for BHP in the largest ever group action before the English courts arising out of the collapse of the Fundão Dam in Brazil in 2015.
  - **Onecom Partners & Ors v Eve Connect & Ors**  
Acted for Onecom in conspiracy claims arising out of the sale and purchase of a telecommunications business.
  - **Various Claimants v Glencore & Ors**  
Acted for the claimants in multi-party shareholder claims brought under s90 FSMA.

Defending Mazda in claims concerning alleged breaches of emissions requirements relating to the production of diesel vehicles.

## Insurance

## Civil Fraud
